Community Based Therapy Service for:

- Children requiring support from two or more therapies (3-8yrs) –[who are not eligible for services from other service providers](#)
- Children with a primary physical impairment who are not eligible for CPLQ (0-18year)

The CCTS team consists of a Team Leader, Speech Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Physiotherapists, Social Work and an Allied Health Assistant.

CCTS works within the Life Course Perspective

- Understanding the child in context (i.e. the child's identity as part of the family unit and as part of other daily environments including school and the wider community);
- A collaborative approach to management which involves the input of various people in addressing issues at the most beneficial and appropriate times in the child's life course (i.e. family, school, peers, professionals);
